I am requesting funding for the Town of Rockland Water District Infrastructure Upgrades in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Rockland, located at 95 Main St, Livingston Manor, NY 12758. The funding would be used for land acquisition of a new site and the purchase of a new water tower. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the current tank is extremely old and deteriorating. The system has large water loss (over 70 percent) and is most likely due to the location. The upgrade would also provide customers at higher elevations better water pressure, and they would no longer require pressure tanks. Leak detection and mapping within the distribution system is also a priority to quickly identify system maintenance and productivity. Upgrades to the metering system will also assist with water loss.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
