I am requesting funding for the Henry Street Connective Corridor in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Binghamton, located at 38 Hawley St Binghamton NY, 13901. The funding would be used for a complete reconstruction and streetscape improvements including narrowing the travel lanes of Henry Street and eliminating unnecessary slip lanes, addressing the perceived impact on safety due to lack of lighting, pedestrian crossings, ADA dropped curbs, and storm management.
